Apart from its main campus in Diyarbakır, the University has campuses for its vocational schools in the counties of Ergani, Çermik, Çüngüş, Bismil and Silvan. Dicle University is engaged with teaching and research to push the boundaries of human knowledge. 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BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS OFFICE

Dicle University International Affairs Office with its well experienced and full time staff coordinates all exchanged programs. It holds orientation programs and provides counselling incoming and out coming students within the framework of Erasmus and Mevlana Exchange Programmes. International Affairs Office arranges social programs for incoming students and provides all necessary documents at their arrival. Besides, it matches each incoming student with one of the students from the corresponding departments. These buddy students help incoming students to adapt to the life in Diyarbakır and Dicle University.

Dicle University has provided its students and teaching staff with an unforgettable experience of studying abroad by partnerships and exchange programs with 341 different universities and institutions all over the world since its foundation in 2004. On the other hand, under Mevlana Exchange Program, we have provided our students and teaching staff with a chance of studying or lecturing abroad in 35 different countries all over the world since 2013.

Dicle University Foreign Affairs Office also participates in international education fairs organized in different countries and having participants from many countries of the world.

EXPERIENCES in INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

For many years, Erasmus and Mevlana exchange programs have been successfully carried out by Dicle University International Affairs Office. More than 1000 students and staff have benefited from Erasmus and Mevlana Exchange Program mobilities. These exchange programs have not only helped to internationalize students and staff but also increased coordination with civil society, government offices and businesses in Diyarbakır. These exchanges programs also provide to share knowledge and experiences and to learn new culture.

On the other hand, Dicle University International Affairs Office carry out international project with The Project Coordination Application and Research Center, established in 2008 within the body of Dicle University, informs students and staff about national and international grant programs and provides technical support. The projects coordinated by the Project Coordination and Research Center contribute to increase the capacity and quality of our university and also contributes to the development of our city and our region.

Since 2008, The Project Coordination Application and Research Center have carried out 5 mobility project for VET learners and staff, 4 IPA (Instrument For Pre-Accession Assistance) project, 10 Mobility project for young people and youth workers. In addition, The Project Coordination Application and Research Center have provided consultancy services to more than 100 projects prepared by different faculties, departments or departments of our university.

At the moment DU have 22 Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility (KA107) Projects and 3 Erasmus+ KA103 Projects with the 1MN Euros budget. The International Credit Mobility Projects range from many countries from Argentina, USA, Nepal, Peru, Moldova, Ukraine, Tunisia, Algeria, Morocco, Palestine, Jordan, Malaysia, India, Indonesia, Azerbaijan, Uzbekistan, Georgia, Vietnam, Ghana, Montenegro, Lebanon Iraq. Additionally DU International Relations Office is planning to apply to Erasmus KA2 Strategic Partnership Projects with its partners in next calls.
