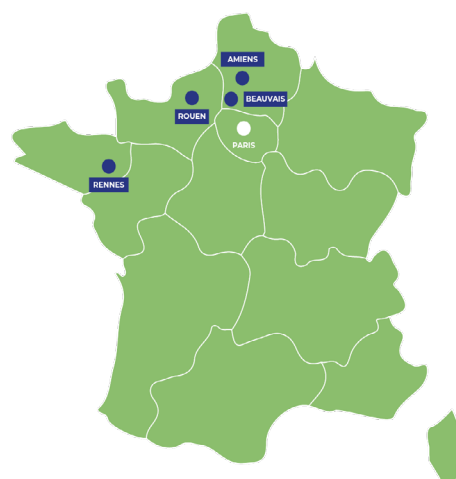

GRADING SYSTEM

30 ECTS = 1 semester (full-time studies); 60 ECTS= 2 semesters (full-time studies);

1 ECTS = 25-30 hours of work of the student (class, study, homework, exams...).

The grading scale goes from 0 to 20 with pass level at 10.

International student transcripts also include the ECTS grade, reflecting the relative position of a grade in a certain reference group.
