Accommodation conditions (if applicable)	Exchange students are guaranteed a room in our residences if they apply by the deadline (usually around December 1 for the Winter semester).
Feeding conditions (if applicable)	We recommend that exchange students apply to live in the East Residence, East Village Townhouses, or West Residence which do not have a mandatory meal plan and students can cook their own meals, which is a less expensive option.
