Average cost of living in the city (monthly money recommendation)	<p>On-campus residence accommodations: \$1200-\$1300 / month x 4 month = \$4800-\$5200</p> <p>Food: \$500 / month x 4 months = \$2000</p> <p>Textbooks: \$500 for semester</p> <p>University Health Insurance Plan (UHIP) - \$252.00 (mandatory)</p> <p>Student Health Plan - \$82.50 (mandatory)</p> <p>Dental Plan - \$112 (you can opt-out only if you have proof that you are covered by another dental insurance plan)</p> <p>Bus Pass - \$163.68 (mandatory)</p> <p>Entertainment + incidentals (student field trips, etc.) : \$500 for semester</p> <p>Total monthly cost: approximately \$2200</p>
