Language requirements for French and English	<p>The exchange program guidelines establish that students must have sufficient knowledge of the French language. To attest the level in French and/or English, students must provide either an official test, a certificate from a language instructor stating the CECR Level equivalence.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For exchange students, a B1 level is recommended in French and in English depending if they choose courses in French or in English. For double-degree students, a B1 level is required in French and in English when they apply for. To obtain the diploma, they will have to obtain a B2 level in French and in English.
French grading system	<p>Grenoble INP – UGA uses the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). One academic year corresponds to 60 ECTS, one semester to 30 ECTS. Exchange students take a maximum of 30 ECTS per semester or 60 ECTS per year.</p>

Academic Calendar	<p>The start and end dates of classes are different from one school to another and depend on the level at which students enter the school. Please refer to the host school to know exactly when the semester is beginning and ending.</p>

Once the students are nominated, you will receive a confirmation email from us. Deadline for nominations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Full academic year or Fall semester: From March 1st to April 1st ▪ Spring semester: From September 15th to October 25th <p>Note: Grenoble INP – Esisar and Grenoble INP – Polytech don't accept nominations for Spring semester.</p>
Application	<p>Incoming students have to complete an online application form (there is no need to send documents by e-mail or mail). Accommodation	<p>In Grenoble: ISSO has accommodation service which provides rooms to students on the different campuses. An on-line application form is made available before each semester.</p> <p>In order to ensure that they will be granted a room (in the limit of the availability), students have to respect deadlines:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Full academic year and Fall semester: Mid-June ▪ Spring semester: Mid - November <p>Contact: studenthousing@univ-grenoble-alpes.fr</p> <p>In Valence: Students from Grenoble INP - Esisar and Grenoble INP – IAE will not receive this link but will be directly contacted by the School's International Relations Department.</p>
Student visa requirements	<p>https://international.univ-grenoble-alpes.fr/getting-organized/visas-and-residence-permits/</p> <p>Students, except European ones (EU-EEA), have to apply for a student visa at the French Embassy of their country of residence. It is highly recommended to start this procedure very early.</p> <p>Some Students have to apply to the CEF on-line procedure as well (65 countries are concerned): https://www.campusfrance.org/en/procedure-studying-in-France</p>
Health insurance	In France, the healthcare system generally takes care of most healthcare costs. Subscription to health insurance is mandatory (upon they arrival) for stays of more than 3 months, unless there is a bilateral agreement between France and your country of origin. This is the case for all member states of the
